## Cemetery News

We have seen some extreme weather conditions over the winter period. Now that the weather is starting to improve, we are now working on fixing potholes, and general clearance of sections, of debris. With the warmer period approaching, the grass growing season also begins. Our teams will be strimming all the grassed sections at regular intervals.

Works are commencing in the older sections of the cemetery. Much needed works in clearing over grown sections have started and will continue through the year. The works will see these areas revitalized, and together with new road improvement's planned, access will be easier for all visitors.



## Noticeboard

A new notice board has been installed at the front gates.

Daily burial's can now be displayed together with the location on the adjoining map.

The board will carry out any news or updates to inform visitors to the cemetery of up and coming remembrance services and works being carried out.





Every effort is made in order to keep the cemetery free of litter. We can only do this with the help of all visitors to the cemetery. Please can we ask all to use the bins provided in all sections of the cemetery. Any large items, i.e. frames, crosses or pots can be left by the bins and our staff will dispose of them on your behalf.

## Grave Reuse Project

Signage has been displayed along all areas that have been earmarked, as potential areas for reuse. The process of ensuring any owners have been contacted is underway. Any visitors that have an interest in these plots are asked to contact the cemetery office. The areas affected are sections O,P,Q & R. There has been works going on clearing the area, which will continue in to the new. There is limited burial space for Roman Catholic and many other religions currently, with the cemetery likely to be full within 8 years.
