PUBLIC NOTICE NEW SOUTHGATE CEMETERY AND CREMATORIUM LIMITED
In order to provide additional space for burials at the New Southgate Cemetery, Brunswick Park Road, New Southgate, London N11 1JJ, the burial authorities for the cemetery, namely the New Southgate Cemetery and Crematorium Limited and the National Spiritual Assembly of the Bahá'ís of the United Kingdom, have been granted powers by section 3 of the New Southgate Cemetery Act 2017 to extinguish rights of burial in certain grave spaces in the cemetery. These powers may only be exercised in relation to grave spaces if at least 75 years has passed from the last date that a right of burial was exercised or, if there has been no burial in the grave space, from the date the right of burial was granted.

Before exercising this power, the burial authority must give at least six months' notice. The notices must be published for two weeks in local newspapers, displayed at the cemetery, and served on certain statutory bodies and the registered owners of the graves concerned. Each notice must identify the grave spaces affected, explain whether any memorials would be removed, and give the date on which the proposals would take effect. The notices must also explain what happens if objections are made, what will happen to removed memorials, and how compensation may be claimed.
